Children's worship guides can be found on the back table. We also offer the following optional children's ministries:

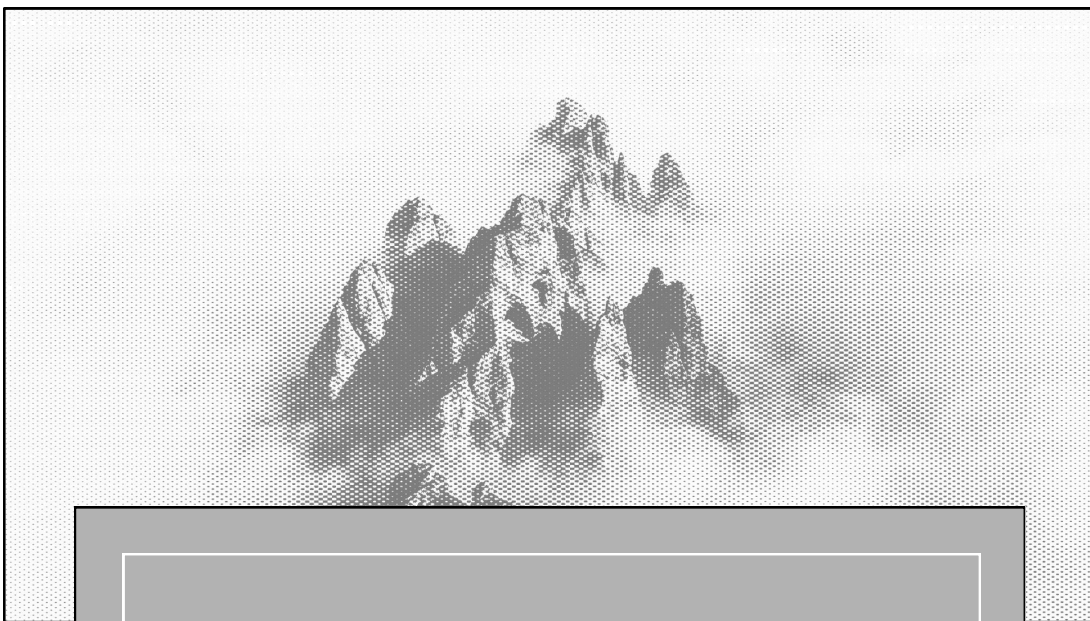

Sermon
